WAIT BEFORE YOU SURRENDER
Giving your kittens TLC for first
eight weeks makes a difference!

HOW YOU CAN HELP?

- Keep your kittens until they are eight weeks old and weigh two pounds.
- Set an appointment with Animal Services to bring the kittens back to the shelter when they are old enough.
- Animal Services will spay the mother cat at no charge to prevent further litters when kittens have been surrendered.
- The mother cat must have a current rabies vaccination and county license; if not, they can be obtained at the time of surgery.
