

* The **Sand Key Beach Renourishment** project will begin in Indian Rocks Beach in early April 2006.

* The unloader and barges will be 1.5 miles offshore and the pipeline will come ashore near 15th Ave. Construction will proceed north to the Belleair Shore/IRB city line (Section 3 - map on reverse).

* The pipeline remains on the beach during construction. Sand ramps provide safe public access to the shoreline.

* In mid- to late May 2006, the pipeline will be removed from the beach in Section 3 and construction will proceed south to Central Ave. (Section 4 - see map).

* In June 2006, the operation will be relocated to Central Ave. Construction will proceed south to Indian Shores.

* Bulldozers and construction equipment operate

AROUND THE CLOCK, creating noise and lights

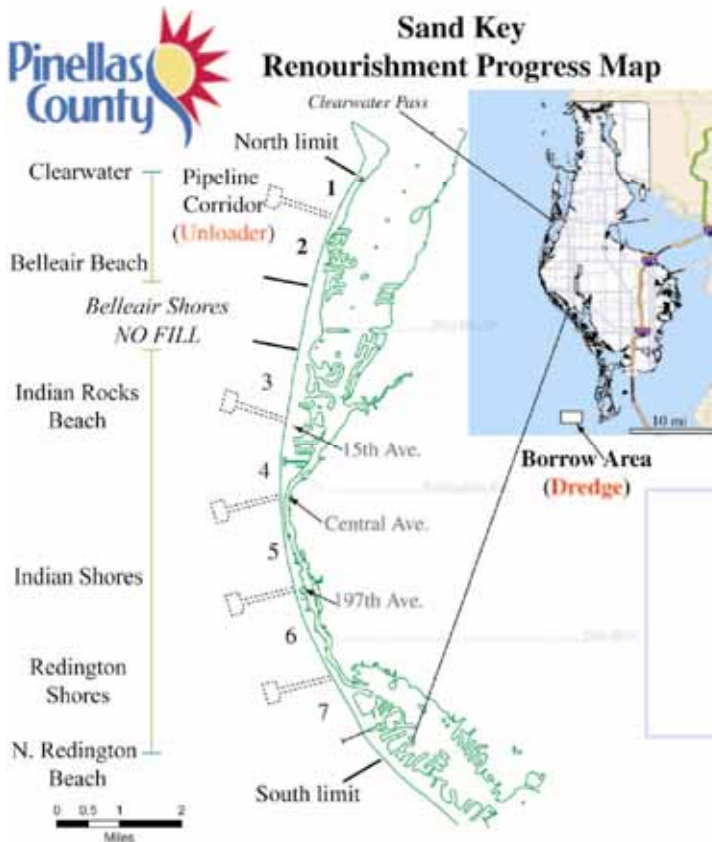


from dusk until dawn. Safety backup alarms are exempt from local noise ordinances.
