Summary:

The Board of County Commissioners (Board) has delegated authority to the County Administrator to approve purchases and other purchasing related processes as per County Code with the requirement that all delegated approvals be submitted for receipt and file on a quarterly basis.

Background Information:

The County Administrator has delegated authority to award contracts up to \$250,000.00. For purchases initiated from Florida State bid or negotiated contracts, the County Administrator is delegated to approve in any amount. The County Administrator has delegated authority to increase master/contract purchase orders previously approved by the Board subject to the same unit pricing and terms; the County Administrator has delegated authority to extend Board approved contracts above the threshold of \$250,000.00, pending all prices, terms and conditions remain the same. And lastly, the County Administrator has been delegated authority to approve change orders and release retainage and close out construction type contracts when the change order does not exceed \$250,000.00 or ten percent (10%) of the total award, whichever is less.



Recommended Action:

Recommend the County Administrator approve and sign the eighth amendment with OK's Cascade, Inc, Monroe, Washington, for Emergency Base Camp Services.

Summary:

The eighth amendment extends the contract for emergency base camp services from August 23, 2015 through August 22, 2016

Background/Explanation:

This contract provides temporary emergency base camp services, including housing and essential life support services, for County employees and mutual aid responders during a catastrophic event. The original contract was awarded by the Board of County Commissioners on August 21, 2007. The contract provides for unlimited renewals of twelve (12) month periods by mutual agreement of the parties.

Fiscal Impact:

Funding is provided through contingency funds. Estimated expenditures are contingent on the severity of the disaster and requirements at that time. As an example, a two-week full mobilization for 1000 people including transportation, set-up, operating costs and demobilization would cost approximately \$3,369,890.00

Contract term extensions provide for price adjustments in an amount not to exceed the average of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all Urban Consumers, Not Seasonally Adjusted, for the twelve months prior to extension, or 3%, whichever is less. There is no adjustment associated with this amendment.

Authority for the County Administrator to approve and sign this eighth amendment is granted under Code Section 2-62(a)(1)

WHEREAS, the Customer and the Contractor now wish to exercise this Amendment for Term Extension,


NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree that the Agreement is amended as follows




- #18 Award of Bid to OK's Cascade, Inc for emergency base camps and services (Contract No 067-0295-P) on the basis of being the only proposal received; contract effective for 12 months with one additional 12-month option of renewal; option may be exercised only if all terms and conditions remain the same and allowing for potential yearly price adjustments in an amount not to exceed the average of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all urban consumers, not seasonally adjusted, for the period of 12 months or three percent, whichever is less, subject to approval of the County Administrator, Chairman authorized to sign and the Clerk to attest (Emergency Management)

Responding to queries by the Members, Interim Director of Emergency Management Sally A Bishop related that this is a contingency contract with no up-front cost, that signing the contract will afford Pinellas County a higher priority for services than jurisdictions without a contract in place should a catastrophic event occur; and that it is likely that the size and requirements of the contract specifications are responsible for the receipt of only one proposal, and discussion ensued with input provided by Director of Purchasing Joe Lauro and County Administrator Spratt

Ms Bishop indicated that she will provide the members with copies of the proposal, and in response to query by Commissioner Morroni, noted that the company has performed extensive work for the State of Florida and comes very highly recommended, confirmed that the company does not have existing contracts with any other Florida counties, and related that the company has tentative plans to open a warehouse facility in Jacksonville which would reduce the County's potential mobilization costs

Summary Explanation/Background:

In April, 2007, the Purchasing Department, on behalf of Emergency Management, let a Request For Proposal (RFP) for an Emergency Base Camps and Services contract A committee, consisting of members from Emergency Management, Utilities and Culture Education & Leisure (Parks Administration), Florida Progress, along with two (2) members of the Purchasing Department acting in an advisory capacity, met on June 8, 2007, to evaluate and score the proposal received according to the following criteria

The Emergency Base Camp idea was developed to provide temporary emergency housing and essential life support services during a catastrophic event The services required to accomplish this include, but are not limited to housing, food, water, electricity, showers, restrooms and laundry for approximately 6,000 County Employees and mutual aid responders. Staff researched the low vendor response to this contract and found that most vendors do not have the capability to provide this service for 6,000 plus workers The number of workers being planned for in a catastrophic event is based on the use of all BCC employees except those with exemptions, all Sheriff's Office personnel, mutual aid personnel for Fire, Law Enforcement, Building, Utilities, Fleet and Public Works, as well as Federal, State and volunteers working within the County

Therefore, the committee agreed to accept the only proposal received and make a recommendation to award the contract to OK'S Cascade, Inc for Emergency Base Camps and Services The pricing that OK'S Cascade Inc

provided is the same pricing per unit that was provided to the State of Florida in their contract

This contract would allow the County to have a contractor available to provide kitchens, showers, laundries, billeting (temporary sleeping structures) toilets, fresh/potable water, black water, grey water, dumpsters, fuel, security and disaster air support in the event of a natural disaster, such as a hurricane. This contract would provide this service for County employees and mutual aid responders working in the field after such disaster when services are unavailable or limited. The contract can be used as a total "turn-key" solution or ala carte, for only the services needed. OK'S Cascade Inc has the ability to mobilize and have its equipment staged within twenty-four (24) hours of a purchase order or task order and fully operational within seventy-two (72) to ninety-six (96) hours of notification.

This is a twelve (12) month contract with one (1) additional twelve (12) month renewal option. Contract renewal will allow for potential yearly price adjustments in an amount not to exceed the average of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all urban consumers, not seasonally adjusted, for the period of twelve months, or three percent, whichever is less, if the terms and conditions remain the same, pending County Administrator approval.

Fiscal Impact/Cost/Revenue Summary:

Funds will be provided through contingency funding.

ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE Pricing will depend on the severity of the storm or disaster and needs at that time. As an example, two week full mobilization, operating costs and demobilization would cost \$3,369,890 for a 1,000 person complete base camp.
