

Pinellas County Charter Review Commission

Issues Identified for Discussion
Revised February 9, 2010

- 1. Pinellas Planning Council**
The authority, duties and structure of the Pinellas Planning Council.

- 2. Non-partisan Election of Supervisor of Elections**
Whether elections for the Supervisor of Elections should be held on a non-partisan basis, without reference to party affiliation.

- 3. Future Charter Review Commissions**
The membership, duration, frequency of convening and other policies relating to subsequent Charter Review Commissions.

- 4. Code of Ethics**
Examination of the provisions of the Charter and BCC policy (as contained in the Code of Ethics) concerning lobbying.

- 5. Single Subject Rule**
Whether charter amendments proposed by a Charter Review Commission should be required to concern only one subject and matter directly related thereto.

- 6. Elected County Mayor**
Whether the charter should be amended to provide for a County Mayor, directly-elected by the voters, who would serve as the head of the Executive Branch of the county government.

- 7. Seven Single-Member Districts**
Whether the districting system for the Board of County Commissioners should be changed from its current system of four single-member and three at-large districts to a system of seven single-member districts.
