

Rebuild Florida registration deadline extended

- Rebuild America is a program to repair and rebuild homes damaged by Hurricane Irma
- The deadline to register has been extended to March 29, 2019

The registration deadline for Rebuild Florida was extended to March 29, 2019. (Previously it was Dec. 23, 2017). The program is a long-term recovery effort to repair and rebuild the homes of Florida families that were significantly damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Irma.

It is a program of the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity and the result of a partnership with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. It was created to help Florida recover from the devastating impacts of Hurricane Irma.

Rebuild Florida will repair and rebuild damaged homes across the hardest-hit communities in the state. Funding is dependent on income, and priority funding will be considered for the elderly, those with disabilities and families with children ages 5 and younger.
