Plan Ahead for Your Hurricane Transportation Needs

During a hurricane evacuation, PSTA buses take you where you need to go for free.

PSTA will attempt to operate all routes until winds reach tropical storm force (40mph). Routes may be modified. Contact PSTA @ (727) 540-1900 or www.psta.net.

- If you need to evacuate to a shelter, just hop on a bus.
- If you have medical needs and no transportation, REGISTER NOW. Call your local fire department. Find that number in the government section of the phone book white pages.
- Sign up NOW for the FREE Community Notification Service to receive emergency information via text messaging. Call (888) 689-8905 from the cell phone you wish to register.
