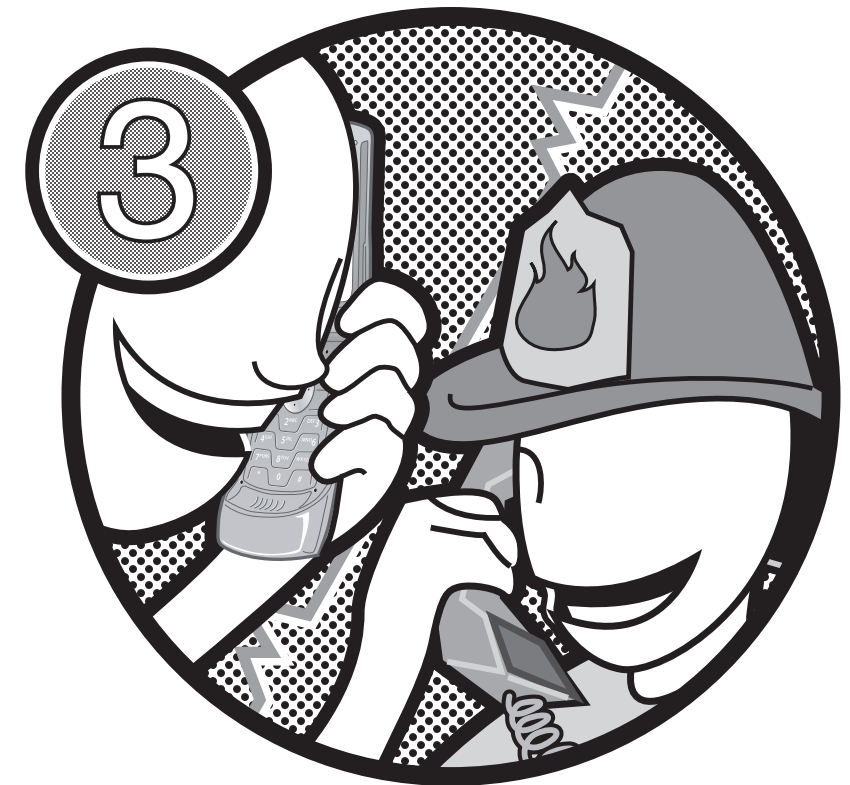

Extra care is needed to be sure these individuals with special needs have emergency survival plans. While it is the responsibility of the individual or the caregiver to have a plan, you can still help by asking people you know if they have a plan. If they don't, encourage them to talk to their physician or call for special needs registration.
