**Minutes of the Monthly Meeting of the

Present at Meeting: Sgt. Zachary Haisch (via phone), Valerie Leonard*, and Rhonda Abbott. Staff and community members present: Drew Wagner, Daisy Rodriguez, Rhonda O'Brien, Stephanie Reed, Dale Williams (phone), Elisa DeGregorio, and Meghan Lomas. (*Consumer)

The regular meeting of the Mobile Medical Unit Advisory Committee (MMUAC) was called to order at 3:05 pm.

- i. **Chairman's Report** – *Note: there was not a quorum present.*
 - i. **Recruitment/Appointment/Removal of Members:** No new members. Discussion based upon three (3) recent changes to the board: departure of Nicole and Preston, Rhonda Abbott is now representing Pinellas Hope, and flyers (distributed). Discussions included:
 - a. The possibility of developing a "business agreement" or MOU with the locations that the van visits to include the assistance with recruitment of members.
 - b. A concerted effort needs to be made to present the opportunity to the shelters. This has not been done since the focus groups – reiterating the ability to assist with transportation. *Transportation may be a key barrier to participation.*
 - c. Valerie and Sean could go speak at the different locations to increase interest.
 - d. Discussion about the time of the meeting, as well as the day of the week. Valerie indicated she is not certain the time of day or day of week is the biggest factor, but possibly self-esteem.
 - e. Daisy discussed the location of the meeting. Potential to take the meeting to where the consumers/clients are may assist in increasing participation.
 - i. Possibility of utilizing space near Safe Harbor (ASB Building) will be researched by Sgt. Haisch – not certain if utilizing Sheriff's Office space could be a deterrent for some individuals.
 - ii. PAR meeting space – Elisa will reach out to PAR to see about the feasibility.
 - f. **Need** at least 2-3 more community members, as well as clients. Staff will work to recruit.
 - i. Daisy, Elisa, and Meghan will work to develop a plan of action to engage the providers with this process.
 - ii. **Approval of Previous Minutes:** Action items were tabled due to the absence of a quorum.
 - iii. **Credentialing & Privileging:** Action items were tabled due to the absence of a quorum.
 - iv. **Unfinished Business:** In follow-up to last month's meeting, the following items were discussed:
 - a. **Lealman and Tarpon Van Locations:** Dr. Choe followed up to Neil Brickfield's request regarding Lealman. While the need does not necessitate the need for the van, Dr. Choe has coordinated an AmeriCorps van to provide services to the area. Daisy reviewed the figures related to the Tarpon Springs homeless population. Based upon the PIT (35 homeless) and

UDS (6-7 clients identified by zipcode) it does not appear to be an area of great need given the figures generated by the current van locations.

- b. **Healthcare Education/Client Engagement Form:** Rhonda Abbott provided the finalized version of the form provided by Laurie Lampert at the last meeting. Rhonda O'Brien reviewed the form and indicated a majority of the information is currently available on a print out from NextGen, these print outs are provided to clients with a care plan and can be provided at any client's request. Discussion about the possibility of having a template of the print out with highlighted areas describing what information is included in which area of the printout may assist with client education. Dale and Drew will work to get a draft of the Test Patient file to assist with the development of the template. Elisa will provide Laurie's email address to Dale to ensure this will assist her with the client education.
- c. **Goodwill Clients:** Previously it was reported that Goodwill was dropping off "bus/van loads" of new clients at Bayside. Drew reported that a plan has been developed with PAR, Goodwill, and Work Release that involves the transportation of 5 or more clients to the clinic. Four or fewer clients transported at one time is not a problem. If the provider will have five or more, they will call Drew to see if the clients can be accommodated. If not they will develop a plan to spread out the influx of clients throughout the week to avoid long delays. At this time, this process seems to be working well.

I. Governance/Operations

- i. **Strategic Planning/Communications:** Ms. Rodriguez discussed the Newsletter and the calendar. HS asked DOH about including screening events within these communications. The example was a mammogram screening event that the clients can participate in with other community members. These notices would assist clients and partners.

Fox 13 was out to the clinic recently and interviewed Lourdes, Dr. Choe, Valerie, and Drew to discuss the clinic and the program. The date the story will air is unknown, although it should be within the coming month. Valerie and others will provide insight if they hear anything.

Brochures have been distributed to the local hospitals and shelters, including Florida Hospital North. There are still some brochures available, if any partners need more. Drew will provide additional brochures to Safe Harbor.

- ii. **Pharmacy Closures:** Stephanie Reed spoke about the recent closures of the pharmacies located within 7 Winn Dixie stores. Pinellas County was notified last week of the closures. The stores have connected with local CVS stores to accommodate the transfer of local prescriptions. This has impacted the delivery of prescriptions, especially to Safe Harbor. The County is working with CVS and the pharmacy providers to get these services back up and running. Based on discussions, it appears CVS is open to resuming these services, but the logistics need to be worked out. Stephanie provided a handout with the locations identified. Clients were notified via text message and robo-call. The closure list will be posted at Bayside and on the van. Clients will be updated when the issue is resolved.
- iii. **Enrollment Out Posting:** Human Services staff have been remotely located at Pinellas Hope – Tuesdays; Safe Harbor – Wednesdays; and WestCare – Thursdays. This has allowed clients to sign up and receive a blue card without having to utilize the timing of clinic staff. This will further assist the clients being enrolled when they need to see the physician, as the application paperwork has

been completed and processed. Dale and Drew will look into any issues regarding the blue card printer for these staff and follow up. Human Services is looking to see if this process would be good to implement at ARC.

- iv. **MMU/Bayside Health Clinic Calendar:** Corrections need to be made to the November calendar. DOH has confirmed they will have coverage for the Monday through Thursday, November 7th – 10th, hours will be standard 8:00 am – 8:00 pm for these days. The Saturday following Thanksgiving is still uncertain. DOH is evaluating availability of coverage and will provide Daisy with a determination in the next week or so.
- v. **Patient Satisfaction Survey Results:** Benchmarking was discussed at the QI Team Meeting and will be incorporated at the beginning of the year to allow for a full year's worth of data prior to implementing benchmarks. The October Satisfaction Survey results were presented with no glaring issues, and generally positive results.

II. Fiscal

- i. **Notice of Awards:** Ms. DeGregorio reported that the County received a Notice of Award regarding the carryover funds for awards that span two years, including Expanded Services 15 and the QI Awards. The total carryover amount is \$311,179.

III. Clinical

- i. **Trend Report for Patient Counts/Encounters:** 1,985 new patients reported so far – this is lower than anticipated, but ahead of the previous year. Mr. Wagner noted some key factors that may be playing a factor including 1) the opening of the Bayside clinic and the change in client flow at the two locations; 2) the length of time the van was located at HEP with the low numbers produced; 3) staffing shortages (doctor and nurse); and 4) patients moving from the van to Bayside to follow Dr. Mungara.

Substance Abuse Expansion and AHCA grants: Mr. Wagner provided an update on the clients who are utilizing services for the Medication Assisted Treatment, and the mental health services provided by BayCare through the AHCA funding. Ms. DeGregorio said that she will include the quarterly reports and monthly updates in future meeting packets for review.

Dental: Mr. Wagner presented the dental trend report showing that we have exceeded our goal for the year of 300 patients. This is widely due to the new dental clinic within Bayside which has greatly improved access and coordination of care with our population. Mr. Wagner also was informed that the dental clinic has accepted patients with “no medical home” and has inquired about the origin of these clients and clarification around the funding source for them. Anecdotally we have heard that these are jail diversion clients coming in from another grant program. Staff will investigate further.

Phone: Mr. Wagner presented the October call volume report for the Bayside Clinic/HCH program. The packet mistakenly included the printout for the September report, however, October's figures were verbally reported. Call volume remains high, but we did not receive any positive or negative feedback on the ability of clients to get through. Staff will investigate further.

In response to last month's question about the implementation of voicemail, Mr. Wagner noted there were 170 voicemails when staff returned from a day of in-service training.

IV. **Other Updates**

i. **New Business:**

Number Printed on Blue Card: Mr. Wagner requested that the phone # printed on the front of the blue card for HCH clients be changed to the main Bayside Clinic # rather than the old phone # used on the van. It was noted that all medical home numbers are also located on the back.

No Shows: It was discussed that there are still a large number of “no shows” for medical appointments. General discussions took place about the difficulty with the population and the barriers and whether or not there are any potential solutions to pro-actively cut down on the no-shows. While we understand that no shows are common across all medical practices, the health center is interested in understanding the problem better. Rhonda O’Brien will produce a No Show report to share at the next meeting. This data will assist in understanding the extent of the problem.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00 pm.

The regular meeting of the Mobile Medical Unit Advisory Committee (MMUAC) was called to order at 3:09 pm.

i. Chairman's Report

- i. **New Member Appointment/Removal of Members:** No new members. Laurie Lampert is filling in for Pam Long, who has left. Nicole Fischer and Preston have moved out of the area. Sgt. Haisch will work to recruit additional members from Safe Harbor.
- ii. **Approval of Previous Minutes:** A motion to approve the minutes dated September 6, 2016 was made by Laurie Lampert and seconded by Sean Murphy. The Council **unanimously approved** the minutes.
- iii. **Credentialing & Privileging:** Rhonda O'Brien identified three (3) new DOH dentists and thirteen (13) new specialists recommended to the Council by the Medical Executive Committee for credentialing and Privileging. The list of names are highlighted in yellow in the meeting packet. Rhonda Abbott made a motion to accept the dentists and specialists for credentialing and privileging and the motion was seconded by Sgt. Haisch. The Council **unanimously approved** the motion.
- iv. **Unfinished Business:** In follow-up to last month's meeting, the following items were discussed:
 - a. **Lealman and Tarpon Van Locations:** Rhonda Abbott inquired if further discussions were had regarding the feasibility/need to locate the van in the Lealman or Tarpon Springs areas. Ms. Rodriguez indicated that Mr. Wagner confirmed that Dr. Choe (DOH) followed up with Mr. Brickfield regarding his inquiry about possible van placement in Lealman. Mr. Wagner was pulled away from the meeting and unable to respond to the inquiry about Tarpon Springs. This item will need to be directed to Mr. Wagner.

Sgt. Haisch cautioned the council to consider the potential for Pasco County homeless individuals to seek the services of the MMU if the van were to be located in certain areas of Tarpon Springs.

- b. **Goodwill Busing Clients to Bayside:** Ms. Abbott inquired if there were still issues with Goodwill transporting clients, by the bus load, to the Bayside clinic. Mr. Wagner will need to follow up with regards to this item.

I. Governance/Operations

- i. **Strategic Planning:** Ms. Rodriguez updated the Council that the revised brochure was completed and is now being distributed to community partners. Ms. Rodriguez has additional copies if any partners would like to make a request.

Ms. DeGregorio shared the October Newsletter with the Council. Rhonda Abbott congratulated staff and thanked them for continuing with the implementation of recommendations from the focus groups, with respect to communications.

The staff continue to meet to review progress towards the communications, access and quality recommendations from the focus groups.

- ii. **MMU Calendar:** The October calendar (included in the meeting packet) for the MMU and Bayside was presented to the Council. Ms. Rodriguez noted that the clinic and MMU will be closed on October 13th for in-service training. She requested that notice be posted at both locations to ensure patient notifications.

Ms. Rodriguez also wanted the council to note the change on Tuesdays. As of October 1st, the MMU will no longer be going to HEP every other Tuesday. The van will travel to St. Vincent DePaul (SVDP) every Tuesday. Sean Murphy noted there are some changes to the SVDP courtyard being discussed at the present time. Sgt. Haisch indicated any potential changes should not impact van usage at SVDP, as the van serves more than just SVDP clients.

- iii. **Patient Satisfaction Surveys:** The results from the August and September 2016 patient satisfaction survey were presented to the council by Rhonda O'Brien. August saw 46 survey respondents, and September has 42. The trend continues to show positive feedback with a majority of the responses being "Usually" and "Always." A couple responses indicated "Sometimes" or "Never," but overall positive. Discussion was had regarding survey responses. Some individuals include their name with their survey. Drew will follow up to see if the "Never" responses were submitted by someone who included name. If so, he can follow up to review the scenario that led to the negative experience/perception.

Ms. Rodriguez noted that question ten (10) is a new question that will be utilized to determine an overall performance assessment. Ms. Rodriguez will follow up with the quality improvement committee meeting to determine next steps in regards to benchmarks for the survey responses.

II. Fiscal

- i. **Notice of Awards:** Ms. DeGregorio reported that the County received two new Notice of Awards from HRSA. The first notice was for \$10,000 Quality Improvement (QI) award based upon last year's performance. This figure was not as large as the previous year, but could have been impacted through the workflow changes that have occurred. The second notice was for \$42,239 Delivery System Health Information Investment (DSHII). This funding will be utilized to connect the MMU's electronic health record (EHR) with other community providers to further assist in the coordination of care.

A motion to accept the two Notice of Awards was made by Rhonda Abbott and seconded by Sgt. Haisch. The motion **passed unanimously**.

Ms. Abbott inquired about the QI award and asked if Pinellas County was working with QI personnel at the other service providers. Ms. Rodriguez indicated that Stephanie Reed and her team are working on that.

Elisa DeGregorio discussed the Budget Period Performance Report (BPR) that was being developed and how the QI process has changed how this will work moving forward. Previous to the current year, the BPR reporting was developed at the end of the year and could not address any data issues in “real time.” The new process of the team meeting quarterly to discuss the reporting and workflow allows the team to address concerns near to when they arise and work to have any “issues” fixed prior to the BPR development and submission.

III. Clinical

- i. **Trend Report for Patient Counts/Encounters:** A copy of the September trend report was provided to the Council members indicating that a total of 1833 unduplicated patients were recorded from January 1st through September 30th for the program. The numbers are slightly above the same time period last year but have been picking up. Ms. O’Brien noted that based on our current projections and pace, we anticipate seeing 2,500 patients for the year, an increase over the 2,239 patients in 2015.

Dental: A copy of the dental trend report was provided to the Council as requested showing that since Bayside has opened on April 18th through September 30th, the clinic saw 216 unduplicated clients in 648 encounters. Overall, all HCH clients receiving dental care totaled 367 clients in 1111 encounters at all dental locations in the County.

Mr. Murphy inquired about the individuals noted in the dental report identified as “No Medical Home.” Ms. O’Brien indicated that DOH is working on updating this information. Dale Williams further explained the issue is missing data points. Mr. Williams explained this was a data transfer issue that DOH and PCHS are aware of and are continually working to resolve.

Phone: Ms. DeGregorio presented the September **call volume report** for the Bayside Clinic/HCH program. In the month of September, the health center received 2550 phone calls broken down as follows:

- 142 Pressed 1 for Office Hours/Locations
- 865..... Pressed 2 for Medical Appointments/Cancellations
- 251..... Pressed 3 for Dental Appointments/Cancellations
- 34..... Pressed 4 for Behavioral Health
- 61..... Pressed 5 for Specialty Care
- 430..... Pressed 6 for Providers
- 287..... Pressed 7 for All Other Questions
- 227..... Pressed 0 for the Operator
- 256..... Timed Out/Error

These figures include September 1st through the 15th, the period of the month in which the phone system remained unchanged. After September 15th, the phone system was updated to include: reduced rings, ringing two (2) desk simultaneously, added the option to indicate the call is from a provider, and added the option to press and be connected to the after hour’s number. If 6 is pressed to indicate a call from the provider, the caller will be transferred to a voicemail box direct to the nurses. This will assist in streamlining the process. Ms. DeGregorio explained there are

additional opportunities for changes to be made, if necessary, but PCHS would like to receive feedback regarding the client experience currently before implementing any additional changes.

An inquiry was made regarding a defined process for responding to voicemails. This is a questions that will need to be responded to by Mr. Wagner. Follow up is necessary to identify: how voicemails are returned, the types of calls, timeframe for return calls, and by whom the calls are returned by.

IV. **Other Updates**

i. **New Business:**

E-application: Daisy Rodriguez explained that PCHS is in the testing phase of an electronic application for services. She inquired about the naming of such a system and provided several suggestions. Discussion was had regarding the utilization of “portal.” Given the discussion it was determined that the term portal may not completely reflect the purpose of the new system. More general terms regarding the application aspect should be utilized to reduce confusion.

Medication Management Education: Laurie Lampert provided the council a copy of a one-page form she has developed to use with the clients she sees at Pinellas Hope’s respite care. She realized a need to assist the clients in becoming active health consumers. The form utilizes several questions the client should ask when seeing a doctor and converts some terminology utilized in a healthcare setting into generalized and relatable terms. The purpose of Laurie bring the form was to inform Bayside and MMU staff that she will be providing this to clients and to be on the lookout to assist these individuals with becoming informed patients.

Rhonda O’Brien inquired if the MMU/Bayside staff had anything currently available electronically that they could print out to provide all patients. Also, Rhonda Abbott indicated this could potentially be shared amongst homeless service providers to begin the education process amongst the shared clientele. Drew Wagner and Melissa Van Bruggen will need to follow up to provide the information to DOH staff and make them aware of the form.

Scenario: Ms. Lampert was uncertain if this advisory council was the appropriate forum, but wanted to inquire as to the process to identify and/or diagnose a homeless client with possible Alzheimer’s or Dementia that is beyond the scope of Pinellas Hope’s capabilities. Suggested contacts provided were for: MMU/Bayside for referral to a specialist, DCF’s Adult Protective Services, or the CARES Unit. Ms. Lampert will follow up with these possible avenues.

Bus Passes: Sean Murphy had an inquiry regarding the timeframe a client of MMU/Bayside could anticipate for eligibility to receive a PSTA bus pass. Dale Williams provided the process for which Mr. Murphy was referencing and through discussions it appears the individual addressed should be eligible. Mr. Williams requested that Mr. Murphy have the individual contact him directly to ensure the information within the database is correct to allow for access to a bus pass.

Hurricane Matthew: Jerry Wennlund provided the group an update on Hurricane Matthew. He recommended everyone stay alert as the cone heads towards Florida. Although the storm may not be a direct hit, it may be a wind event.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:37 pm.

ACA Health Care Marketplace - Open Enrollment Begins November 1, 2016

Pinellas County residents can sign up for an affordable health plan that meets their needs and their budgets at [HealthCare.gov](#) or by making an appointment with a [Pinellas County Navigator](#). Open Enrollment runs through January 31, 2017. Health coverage can start as soon as January 1, 2017 for consumers who sign up by December 15, 2016.

Pinellas County Navigators can:

A staff member will be available on Tuesdays at Pinellas Hope; Wednesdays at Safe Harbor; and Thursdays at WestCare. By completing the application for enrollment at the shelter, clients will save time at Bayside or the MMU when trying to schedule a medical appointment.

Dental Community Resources Available

Homeless individuals are less likely than the general population to seek dental care, and are the least likely of all vulnerable populations to carry a toothbrush, partially due to lack of access to facilities where they can attend to personal hygiene. They have limited financial resources, often have no health insurance, and are unhoused or housed in unstable situations. The [Tampa Bay Oral Health Coalition](#) offers a web-based community based dental providers listing who serve those clients most in need. 



1. How often did you get an appointment as soon as you needed?







2. When you phoned MMU after normal business hours, how often did you get an answer to your medical question as soon as you needed?





3. How often did the doctor explain things in a way that was easy to understand?






4. How often did MMU staff listen to you carefully and show respect for what you had to say?






5. When you had a blood test, x-ray or other test, how often did someone from MMU follow up to give you the results?



6. If you were referred to a specialist for a particular health problem, how often did the MMU staff seem informed and up-to-date about the care you got from the specialist?





7. How often did someone talk to you about specific goals for your health?






8. How often did someone talk with you about a personal problem, family problem, alcohol use, drug use, or a mental or emotional illness?



9. How frequently do you find useful the information provided to you by MMU staff about available Community Resources?








