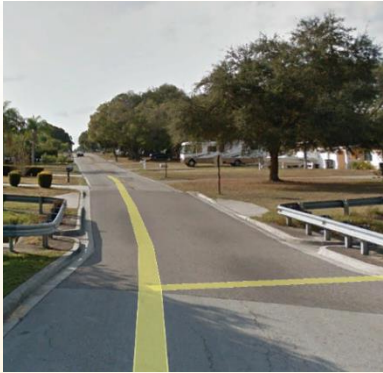

Project Overview

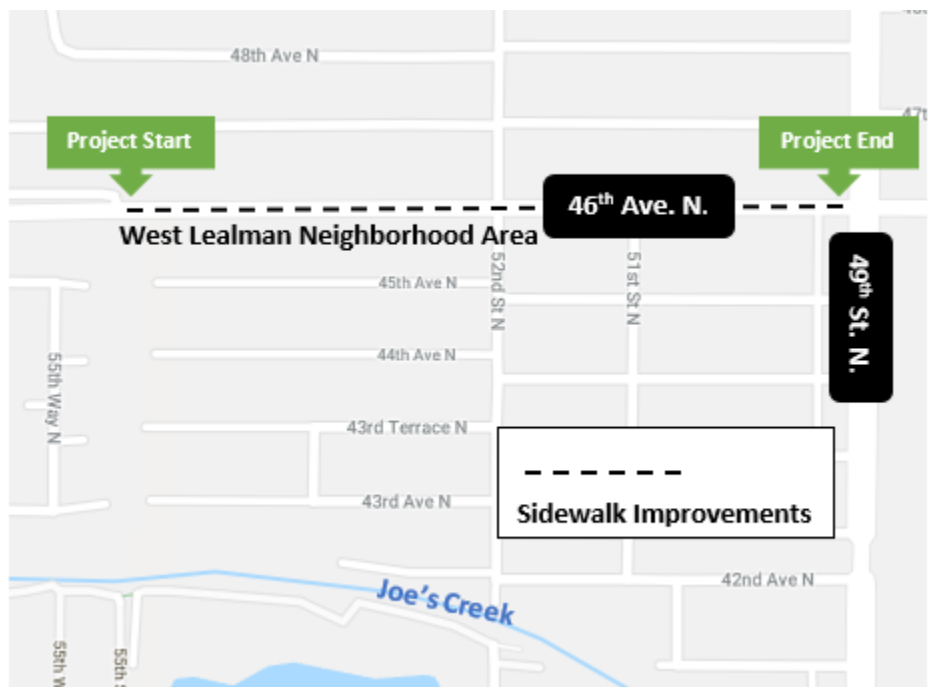
Pinellas County Public Works, through the County's Capital Improvement Program, is making sidewalk improvements along both sides of 46th Avenue N. in St. Petersburg through the unincorporated area of West Lealman. The project consists of the design of ADA-compliant sidewalks and curb ramps to provide a safer pathway for pedestrians and bicyclists.

The 46th Avenue N. roadway is an existing two-lane collector road that extends across the County from east to west. The project begins at the western boundary of Lealman, from west of drainage outfall along 55th Street N., and continues east for approximately 0.5 miles to the intersection of 49th Street N. The project extends through a residential neighborhood that does not have existing sidewalks.

Project Schedule – Next Steps

- Design Start: Spring 2018
- Design End: Spring 2019
- Construction Start: Spring 2019
- Construction End: Fall 2020

This project is funded through the Penny for Pinellas program.

Additional Project Information

An adjacent sidewalk project is planned by the Town of Kenneth City. The project includes an 8-foot wide sidewalk in the median of 46th Avenue N. that will extend to the city limits at 55th Street N. To provide continuity, the County sidewalk design will extend the 8-foot wide sidewalk on the north side of 46th Avenue N., from 55th Street N to 49th Street N.

Approximately 78 driveways along the corridor will be reconstructed with 6-inch concrete driveway aprons to a location 2-feet beyond the back of new sidewalk to accomplish driveway harmonization. Milling and resurfacing the asphalt pavement is proposed and new pavement markings will be provided.

There is an existing box culvert crossing under 46th Avenue N. as part of a drainage outfall flowing north to south along the 55th Street N. right-of way corridor. The length of the box culvert will be extended in both directions to accommodate new sidewalk crossings over the box culvert.
