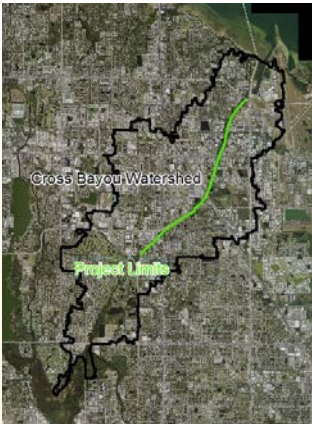

## Project Overview

The Cross Bayou Canal (CBC) Flood Control Project is focused on extending the life of the canal and will address dredging, debris and exotic vegetation removal, canal bank stabilization and acquisition of property rights. This project is unique in that it requires immediate implementation to remove exotic vegetation in order to gain access to the canal in several areas. As the design and permitting for dredging, removal of mangroves in the conveyance way, bank stabilization and acquisition of property rights proceeds Implementation Phase I, exotic vegetation removal, is being implemented.

    - Survey, data gathering and model refinement
  - Phase II and III
    - Design, permitting and development of construction documents, and documents for property rights acquisition
- Implementation - Construction
  - Phase I
    - Removal of exotic vegetation (on-going)
  - Phase II
    - Acquisition of property rights
  - Phase III
    - Vegetation Management in canal conveyance way
    - Dredging to elevation -4.3 in canal conveyance way
    - Canal bank stabilization

- Design Start: May 2016
- Design Finish: April 2019
- Construction Start: September 2018
- Construction Finish: September 2021
