Project Overview

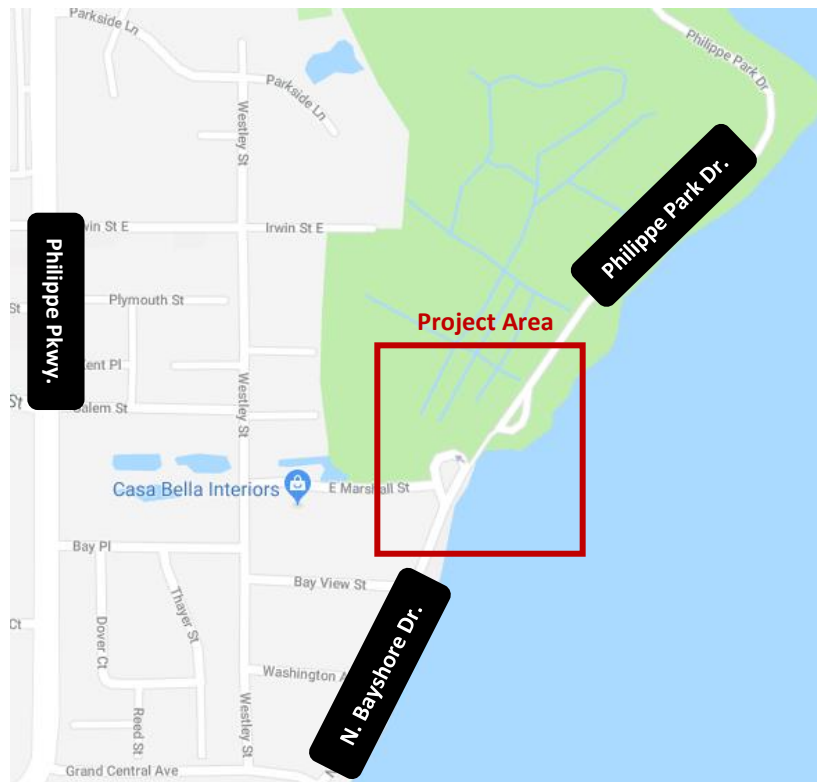
Pinellas County and the City of Safety Harbor are working together for the replacement of the pedestrian bridge connecting the north end of Bayshore Drive to Philippe Park. This bridge was originally built in 1984 and has outlived its useful life. This bridge will be replaced with a 12 foot wide steel truss bridge. Sidewalk connections to the bridge will be improved to allow better access for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Project Schedule – Next Steps

- Design Start: March 2018
- Design End: November 2018
- Construction Start: June 2019
- Construction End: January 2020

This project is currently being prepared for construction advertisement.

This project is funded through settlement funds from the Deepwater Horizon accident and an interlocal agreement with the City of Safety Harbor.
