## Project Overview

The purpose of the Weedon Island Preserve Salt Marsh Restoration Project is to restore the natural habitat and water flow through Weedon Island and adjacent smaller islands to a natural ecological system. Phase I of the project consisted of a study of the island's water flow patterns, exotic vegetation, and other natural resources. The Phase I Study will determine future phases of the Project and give a plan for achieving additional grant funding from the Water Management District.

## Project Schedule – Next Steps

- Study Start: July 2017
- Study Finish: December 2018

Subsequent design phases will be determined in coordination with the Water Management District.
