Be Aware

BE PREPARED!



Hurricane season officially begins
June 1 and ends November 30.

- ▶ Be aware of your evacuation zone, and be prepared to leave when ordered to do so.
- ▶ All mobile home residents must evacuate during any level of evacuation.
- ▶ If you must evacuate, go to a friend's or relative's home; use a shelter as a last resort.
- ▶ Avoid driving to another city; hotel rooms are likely to be full.
- ▶ Be aware of how long your preparation will take and plan accordingly.
- ▶ In the event of an approaching hurricane, plan for its arrival as well as the aftermath.
- ▶ **Your water, sewer, and solid waste services may be interrupted.**

Mini Checklist

- Freeze water in plastic jugs.
- 5-gallon buckets with tight-fitting lids
- Liquid chlorine bleach
5.25% sodium hypochlorite
- Kitty litter
- Heavy duty plastic trash bags
- Remove large pieces of yard debris.
