## YARD WASTE RECYCLING

No grass clippings or leaves. Cut brush into 4 feet lengths and stack at the curb (no bags or cans). Brush piles cannot exceed 4 feet high or 8 feet long.

## NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE!

**Aluminum Cans** – Any empty aluminum can such as soda or juice cans. Rinse and crush if possible.

**Cardboard** – Clean, empty, dry corrugated (3-layer) cardboard boxes or packaging. Please flatten boxes. No pizza boxes.

**Newspapers** – Dry newspapers and inserts. No string or twine. It's okay to put inside a paper bag.

**Plastic Bottles** – Any empty plastic bottle with a “neck” (opening smaller than the base) such as water, soda, shampoo, or ketchup. No need to check for #1 or #2—just “check for a neck”. Bottles only; no tubs, cups, or bags. Labels okay. No caps or lids. Rinse and crush if possible.

**Steel (Tin) Cans** – Any empty steel cans such as soup cans. Labels and lids okay. Rinse if possible.
