## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

### NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE!

**Aluminum Cans** – Any empty aluminum can such as soda or juice cans. Rinse and crush if possible.

**Glass Bottles & Jars** – Any empty glass jar or bottle (all colors). Labels okay. No caps or lids.

**Milk & Juice Cartons** – Any empty gable-top beverage container such as milk, half and half, or orange juice cartons. Rinse and crush if possible.

**Newspapers** – Dry newspapers and inserts. No string or twine. It's okay to put inside a paper bag.

**Plastic Bottles** – Any empty plastic bottle with a “neck” (opening smaller than the base) such as water, soda, shampoo, or ketchup. No need to check for #1 or #2—just “check for a neck”. Bottles only; no tubs, cups, or bags. Labels okay. No caps or lids. Rinse and crush if possible.

**Steel (Tin) Cans** – Any empty steel cans such as soup cans. Labels and lids okay. Rinse if possible.
