RECYCLING GUIDELINES

NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE!

Aluminum Cans – Any empty aluminum can such as soda or juice cans. Rinse and crush if possible.

Appliances/Mixed Metal – Appliances or scrap metal.

Cardboard – Clean, empty, dry corrugated (3-layer) cardboard boxes or packaging. Please flatten boxes. No pizza boxes.

Glass Bottles & Jars – Any empty glass jar or bottle (all colors). Labels okay. No caps or lids.

Mixed Paper – Any clean, dry paper item that tears, such as white or colored paper, shredded paper, office paper, magazines, phone books, catalogs, junk mail & envelopes, wrapping paper, and paperboard items such as cereal boxes or paper towel rolls. No soiled or wax coated paper such as milk cartons.

Newspapers – Dry newspapers and inserts. No string or twine. It's okay to put inside a paper bag.

Plastic Bottles – Any empty plastic bottle with a “neck” (opening smaller than the base) such as water, soda, shampoo, or ketchup. No need to check for #1 or #2—just “check for a neck”. Bottles only; no tubs, cups, or bags. Labels okay. No caps or lids. Rinse and crush if possible.

Yard Waste – Loose brush (no bags) can be dropped off at any of the five Recycling & Brush Site drop off sites listed at left. Show proof of residency such as a water bill. For special pickups, limbs cannot exceed 5 ft.

St. Petersburg residents may call the Sanitation Dept. (893-7398) to arrange a free pickup of an unwanted television. Call first, then put your TV at the curb on the date specified.

BUSINESS RECYCLING:

Recycling containers for cardboard are available to businesses for a fee. Call 893-7934.

MULTI-FAMILY RECYCLING:

Requests for outdoor recycling containers for apartments or condos must come from the facility's manager. Recycling is not available for individual units. Facility managers may call 893-7398.
