- Where to recycle everyday items such as TVs, computers, cell phones, or toner cartridges

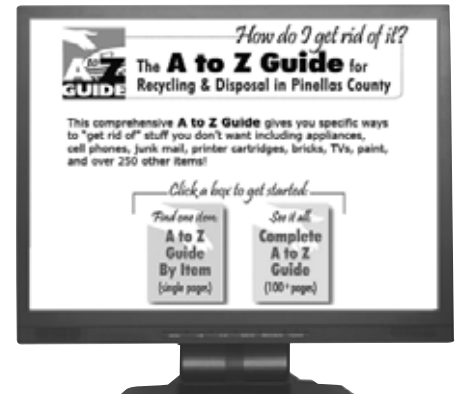
- How to recycle or safely dispose of unusual items such as syringes
